

Guide to Installing Custom HoloKote for Magicard Rio Pro 360 printer


Installing a Custom HoloKote to your Helix printer can be done in two ways, both through your printer driver.

If the printer is connected to an Internet-enabled PC: By downloading the HoloKote securely from Magicards HoloKote server.

If the printer cannot be connected to an Internet-enabled PC: By downloading the HoloKote image file from your support account and installing it offline from a connected PC.

Online Installation

Open the Magicard driver in the <**Devices and printers**> area of your Windows OS and then open <**Adjust printer options**>



Navigate to the <Card front> tab and click the <Security options> button, this option will be disabled if you do not have a YMC or YMCK dye film loaded in your printer.





The <**Security options**> tab gives you an overview of your current HoloKote settings. To retrieve your new Custom HoloKote click <**Manage HoloKotes**>. This will bring up a dialogue showing the printer driver connecting to the secure HoloKote servers and retrieving your design from your account.



Once complete, this interface will show your currently <Installed> HoloKotes and <Available> custom designs from your support account.



To install the HoloKote to your printer select your design in the **<Available>** panel. Highlight one memory slot from the 10 preinstalled designs. When ready click the transfer arrow between the two panels, this will overwrite the selected preinstalled design with your Custom HoloKote.



Offline installation

If your printer cannot be connected to an Internet-enabled computer it is possible to perform an offline installation.

To do this you will need to download your Custom HoloKote file from your online support account and transfer it to a computer connected to your Helix printer via USB or Ethernet.






